Guidance for the Celebration of the Sacrament of Confirmation 2026

IN GENERAL

- Each year the Confirmation liturgy booklet is updated – please make sure you are working from the updated booklet.
- **The Confirmation Liturgy Booklet 2025 is to be followed exactly as it is – nothing should be added to it or taken from it.**
- Only sacred music should be chosen to accompany the liturgy. There is a vast source of appropriate music in the *Grow in Love* series resources.
- Readers are required for:
 - 1) The first reading;
 - 2) The second reading;
 - 3) The Prayer of the Faithful;
 - 4) Post-Communion reflection, if one is chosen.
- If desired, symbols/art work may be used to decorate the church beforehand. If gifts/symbols are to be brought forward this should be done before the liturgy begins.
- Only the bread and wine should be brought forward at the offertory.
- Candidate, parents, family members and sponsor should sit as decided locally.

PHOTOGRAPHY and APPLAUSE

- Mobile phones, tablets, or cameras are not permitted during the ceremony.
- Group photographs should be kept to a minimum and preferably be taken outside the church.

- There should be no applause until the ceremony ends.
- An announcement regarding photography and applause should be made before the ceremony begins.

Music

- Only sacred music is permitted. A wide selection of suitable music can be found in the Grow in Love series resources.
- Priority should be given to the sung parts of the Mass: Lord, Have Mercy; Psalm; Alleluia; Holy, Holy; Mystery of Faith; Great Amen; and Lamb of God.
- In order to avoid the semblance of performance, choirs or class groups should sing from a position that does not face the congregation.
